North Road Cemetery was established in 1853 by South Australia's first Anglican Bishop, Augustus Short, on two acres that he owned. The cemetery now covers 18 acres and seen more than 24,000 burials. Some notable interments include Daisy Bates, Richard Schomburgk and John Downer. The tour will be followed by lunch at the Caledonian Hotel, 219 O'Connell Street (cnr Barton Terrace West), North Adelaide.
