

Botanical Name	Origin	Label Text
Arthropodium fimbriatum		Flowering October to February, this perennial usually has groups of 2 to 4 flowers along the flower stems. Leaves usually about 8cm long. Flowers both Summer and Autumn in a massed display of bright blue or violet tubular flowers.
Baeckea virgata		Likely to become known as Babingtonia bidwillii. A bushy erect shrub growing to 3m in height and width. It has dark green linear leaves and white flowers occurring in clusters in late spring and summer.
Cavendishia acuminata	Columbia to Ecuador	Evergreen shrub to 1.8m. New pink growth. Tubular scarlet flowers to 2cm spring/autumn. Humus-rich soil, filtered sun.
Cistus purpureus		Showy, orchid-pink 3 inch flowers with a darker red spot appear during summer on this heat-loving, evergreen shrub. Dark green leaves are grey and hairy beneath. Durable dry bank cover or rock garden plant. Tolerates poor soils. Plant in full sun for best growth and flowering. Hardy in zone 7b. Quickly reaches 4 feet tall and wide. Keep soil moist until completely established. Drought tolerant when established. Fertilizer not needed. Cut old stems occasionally to keep plant vigorous. Pinch or shear to thicken growth.
Cotoneaster congesta		Evergreen shrub, forming mounds to 60cm. Pink-red or white flowers - bright red fruit. Summer. Cool site.
Cotoneaster salicifolius		Evergreen shrub, has bright red fruit that persist through the winter. 'Scarlet Leader' is an excellent, low growing, ground hugging, dark glossy green ground cover that turns a red-purple leaf color in the winter.
Cuphea oreophila	Mexico	Evergreen shrub to 1m. Red flowers. Sunny protected position. Water in summer. Rare.
Dierama ambiguum		Wandflower 1m. heads of purple flowers, summer, on waving wands. Sun, moist, well-draining soil
Diospyros whyteana	South Africa	Shrub to 6m, suitable for hedging. Reddish new growth spring/summer. Well-drained moist soil. Shelter from wind.
Drimys winteri	Chile; Argentina	Shrub/tree to 15m. Clusters fragrant cream flowers spring/ summer. Cool climate, shelter. Moist well-drained soil.
Dyckia brevifolia		Small bromelioid 0.6m x0.5m Partial shade, drought and frost tolerant. Flowers are yellow on tall stems.
Dyckia frigida		Small bromelioid, well-drained soil, partial shade. Panicles of orange flowers.
Escallonia langleyensis		Glossy foliage, abundance pink-white flower late Spring to Autumn, hardy. 1.5m x 1m. Sun, well-drained soil.
Graptophyllum excelsum	Chile	Shrub to 2m. Inflorescence spike-like; red flowers in whorls. Well-drained soil, semi-shade. shrub or small tree 1.5m to 8m high, usually no more than 4m, with multiple stems. Deep red, tubular flowers spring & early summer. Sun. Birds.
Hakea verrucosa	WA	Small, spreading shrub to 2m. Prickly foliage. Attractive species; flowers turning from white to red on maturity. Autumn-spring. Hardy. Full sun to part shade.

<i>Hypericum beanii</i>	China	Vigorous tall evergreen shrub. Clusters large star-shaped yellow flowers summer. Part shade, fertile well-drained soil.
<i>Leonotis leonurus</i>	South Africa	Evergreen shrubby perennial to 1.8m. Tall straight stems bear whorls of orange flowers late summer. Suit dry conditions.
<i>Melaleuca blaerifolia</i>		Small shrub 1-1.3mH x 1.5mW with tiny crowded leaves on stiff white stems. Maroon buds and attractive lime green flowers in spring. Sun or part shade in dry or moist well drained soils. Drought hardy, tough.
<i>Melaleuca teretifolia</i>		Small to medium shrub 1 to 3 m. The linear leaves 40-60 mm long tapering to a sharp point. The white flowers in globular-shaped clusters 20 mm diameter. Hardy. Sun.
<i>Ophiopogon jaburan</i> ( <i>Argenteus Vittatus</i> )	Japan	Clumping perennial. Sprays white bell-shaped flowers summer, blue berries. Part/full sun. Moist well-drained soil.
<i>Saxifraga paniculata</i>	China, Iceland, Norway	Mat forming perennial. Spread 25cm, to 5cm high. Creamy white flowers in small heads to 30cm high. Summer. Free draining, fertile soil. Part shade.
<i>Senecio petasites</i>	Mexico	Evergreen shrub 1.2mH x 1.5mW. Prefers rich, moist, well-drained soils,protected sunny position. Frost & drought tender. Yellow daisy flowers in winter.
<i>Teucrium marum</i>	W Mediterranean	Erect shrub to 50cm. Small purple flowers in whorls, summer. Well-drained soil, sun.
<i>Vestia foetida</i>	Chile	Evergreen shrub to 2m. Lemon-yellow tubular flower spring/summer. Rich well-drained soil, sun/light shade.
