Adriana quadripartita - (formerly klotzchii)		Spreading shrub to 2m. Small red-tinged flowers in short spikes spring/summer. Coastal, sandy soil, salt tolerant.
Allocasuarina scleroclada		She-oaks, 15m trees, fine branchlets drought resistant, roots put nitrogen back into the soil. Bird attracting.
Baeckea crenatifolia		Slender shrub to 30cm tall, fine small leaves, masses of white flowers. Cup-shaped papery seed-capsule to 3mm.
Baloghia imophylla		Attractive tree to 10m. Thick glossy evergreen foliage. Showy white, separate male/female flowers during early spring. Native to eastern Australia.
Bartlettina sordida	Mexico	Shrub to 3m. Young stems densely hairy. Broad. Toothed leaves. Dense heads of fragrant violet flowers. Open, well-drained soil.
Bauhinia natalensis		Small, dainty shrub to 1.5m high. Fragrant white flowers in summer. Semi-shade. Fertile, well-drained soil.
Buckinghamia celsissima		Small tree to 8m. Glossy darkgreen leaves. Spectacular cream fragrant flowers autumn. Attractive to birds, bees. Sun. Well-drained soil.
Calothamnus homalophyllus		Erect shrub to 2mHx2mW. Spikes of red one-sided bottlebrush flowers in Spring. Well-drained, soil, dappled shade. Bird attracting. WA
Calothamnus quadrifidus var dwarf form		Hardy shrub to 3 m. Bottlebrush with small petals, large bright red stamen bundles attractive to honeyeating birds. Flowers Jun-Dec.
Cantua buxifolia		Shrub to 3m. Drooping clusters pink tubular flowers, spring. Sheltered position, moist well-drained fertile soil.
Carya glabra		Deciduous tree to 30m. Separate male-female flowers. Male flowers yellow-green, drooping catkins in clusters which appear in spring.
Cavendishia acuminata	Columbia to Ecuador	Evergreen shrub to 1.8m. New pink growth. Tubular scarlet flowers to 2cm spring/autumn. Humus-rich soil, filtered sun.
Citrobatus lancioliis		Undershrub or tree, trunk grey, cylindrical. Sweet yellow-green flowers, fruit is a purple berry.
Cordyline sp		Evergreen multi-stemmed shrub to 2m. Attractive black berries after flowering. Sun or shade, moist soil.
Cotoneaster congesta		Evergreen shrub, forming mounds to 60cm. Pink-red or white flowers - bright red fruit. Summer. Cool site.
Cuphea oreophila	Mexico	Evergreen shrub to 1m. Red flowers. Sunny protected position. Water in summer. Rare.
Diospyros whyteana	South Africa	Shrub to 6m, suitable for hedging. Reddish new growth spring/summer. Well-drained moist soil. Shelter from wind.
Drimys winteri	Chile; Argentina	Shrub/tree to 15m. Clusters fragrant cream flowers spring/ summer. Cool climate, shelter. Moist well-drained soil.
Escallonia 'Glory of Donard'		Evergreen shrub with glossy, dark-green leaves. It bears pale-pink flushed white flowers in early summer which open from pink buds.
Euryops linearis		Shrub to 1.5m. Prune for shape. Yellow, daisy-like flowers in summer. Full sun. Rare.
Felicia echinata		Rounded, bushy shrub to 60cm. Clusters lilac/white, daisy-like flowers. Summer.Full sun. Well-drained, humus-rich, gravelly soil.
Felicia echinata	South Africa	Rounded, bushy shrub to 60cm. Clusters lilac/white, daisy-like flowers. Summer.Full sun. Well-drained, humus-rich, gravelly soil.
Fuchsia cinnabarina		Erect/spreading shrub to 2m. Pink flowers spring/summer. Moist well-drained fertile soil. Sun/part shade.

Graptophyllum excelsum	Chile	Shrub to 2m. Inflorescence spike-like; red flowers in whorls. Well-drained soil, semi-shade. shrub or small tree 1.5m to 8m high, usually no more than 4m, with multiple stems. Deep red, tubular flowers spring & early summer. Sun. Birds.
Graptophyllum excelsum		Shrub or small tree 1.5m to 8m high, usually no more than 4m, with multiple stems. Deep red, tubular flowers spring & early summer. Sun. Birds.
Leonotis leonurus	South Africa	Evergreen shrubby perennial to 1.8m. Tall straight stems bear whorls of orange flowers late summer. Suit dry conditions.
Lepechinia salviae		Shrub to 2m. Inflorescence spike-like; red flowers in whorls. Well-drained soil, semi-shade.
Leptospermum laevigatum		Large, bushy shrub, to 5m in height by a similar spread. Leaves are grey-green, generally oval-shaped 15-30 mm long by 5-8 mmm wide. White 5-petalled flowers, followed by small woody fruits. Hardy shrub for moist soils, coastal tolerant. Full sun or part-shade
Melaleuca laterila		Shrub 1.5 h x 1 m w. Tip prune. Orange-red, bottlebrush flower spikes summer. Well-drained soil, full sun, attracts bird.
Melaleuca pulchella		Spreading shrub, from 30 cm to 1.7 m, numerous arching branches bear many small leaves, leaf undersides have large oil glands. Pink to mauve claw-like flowers spring to autumn, followed by small urn-shaped seed pods 0.6 cm in diameter]
Mentha piperita		Peppermint. Culinary mint. Moist, part-sun to shade. Flowers attract bees.
Olearia x scilloniensis		Compact evergreen shrub, silver-grey leaves, masses of mauve-blue flowers Spring. Well-drained soil. Sun.
Ozothamnus turbintum		Medium shrub, 1mx2m, moist/well-drained soil, cream flower late Spring, early winter
Plectranthus verticillatus		Pleasantly aromatic, soft, perennial herb to c. 25 cm high, semi-succulent; branches prostrate to ascending, rooting at nodes, ± glabrous to shortly and minutely hairy; hairs antrorse, multicelled, usually with red sessile glands.
Podocarpus elatus		Shrub/tree to 15m. Suitable hedge. Purple-black edible fruit autumn Well-drained acid soil. Part-shade/full sun.
Ruellia ciliosa		Small evergreen bushy shrub with violet flowers over a long period. Semi-shade
Russelia equisetiformis		Open shrub to 1.5m, slender arching branches. Scarlet tubular flowers. Spring to Autumn Hardy
Saxifraga paniculata		Mat forming perennial. Spread 25cm, to 5cm high. Creamy white flowers in small heads to 30cm high. Summer. Free draining, fertile soil. Part shade.
Senecio petasites		Evergreen shrub 1.2mH x 1.5mW. Prefers rich, moist, well-drained soils, protected sunny position. Frost & drought tender. Yellow daisy flowers in winter.
Solanum diflorum		Shrub to 1.5m. White flowers and round red fruits in pairs along stems. Pots and garden.
Tagetes lemmonii		Fast-growing shrub to 1.5m. Yellow flowers autumn-winter. Well-drained soil, sunny spot.
Vestia foetida		Evergreen shrub to 2m. Lemon-yellow tubular flower spring/summer. Rich well-drained soil, sun/light shade.
Vitis coignatia		Deciduous vine: leaves crimson in autumn. Black berries in summer. Sunny aspect, moist well-drained rich soil.
